

Gift Aid Donor Annual Statements

These are available at the back of your "home" church today for those who give either by envelope or standing order. For envelopes 101 to 299 the home church is Our Lady Queen of Peace (organiser Theresa McIntyre), for envelopes 301 to 499 the home church is St. Bede's (organiser Paul Carpenter), for envelopes 501 to 699 the home church is Our Lady Immaculate (organiser Eric Moran) and for 701 to 899 the home church is St. John Boste (organiser Peter Brewster).

As envelopes are transferred, unopened back to the home church for counting, which takes time, then anything given in the last two weeks of the financial year may not have been included in the 2016/2017 year but will be included in the next year. If you would like a detailed statement of how your total for the year was reached please ask your organiser. Any statements not collected after Sunday 1st October will be safely stored.

These arrangements are to satisfy the tax inspectors and have enabled us to claim £21,681.62 in Gift Aid and £7,100 under the Small Gift Aid Scheme (this is based on the loose collections) for the 16/17 year, giving a total of just under £29,000. Thanks to all of you for your donations which have allowed us to claim this significant amount of extra money from HMRC.
